I hope you're all having a great spring! We just wanted to stay in touch, let you know what we're up to and share some amazing opportunities for getting involved in prison ministry.

It's been an exciting year so far. Our service at NCCF (Rockwell City) has continued to grow - a few weeks ago we had 45 guys show up! On Easter, It was our privilege to baptize 10 new men into God's family and then celebrate with a banquet catered by the good folks at Hy-Vee in Fort Dodge. The inmates are stepping up as leaders inside the facility and creating a culture of hope and transformation. It's amazing to see!

In Fort Dodge, we've been able to partner with Prison Fellowship to bring volunteers back in for the first time in nearly 5 years (more on that below)! We're continuing to provide clothing and hygiene supplies to the men at the Fort Dodge Halfway House as well as free haircuts and bus passes for men who're completing their treatment assignments on time via tablet. We've also started producing video devotional content for the guys that's available via their treatment tablets. Out goal is to prepare and support individuals for a successful transition back to society. This makes safer communities for us all.


